

## Undergraduate Mathematics Competition (West: UTC -2.30 to +5.00, East: UTC +5.30 to +13.00)

## Competition date - 9 October 2021 Student entries close 19 September 2021

<b>Eligibility</b> :	Undergraduate students at pre-registered universities located between UTC -2.30 and UTC +13.00 on the Competition Date.
Entry:	<b>Students</b> can enter <b>individually</b> or in <b>pairs</b> , with prizes for the top 10 individuals and pairs, as well as creative problem solving.
	The best <b>universities</b> will be determined based on the scores of their 3 best individuals and 2 best pairs, no more than 4 students of any gender.
	Universities can enter students in the Competition even if there are not enough students to calculate a University score as above. The students will receive scores and be eligible for individual/ pairs/ merit prizes.
Format	East: Two three-hour exams, West: One three-hour exam (same paper as second East exam), at times depending on the time-zone.
Problems:	Challenging problems using core undergraduate mathematics. Possibly one open problem. Previous competition papers on the website.
Prizes:	More than AU\$120,000 in total prize money.
COVID-19:	Can change everything, as in 2020. Organisers will announce any changes as soon as possible.
